

REBECCA LYNN NEW ART SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE: The Rebecca Lynn New Art Scholarship was established in 2013 to honor Rebecca New – Elementary School Art Teacher at Gold Hill Elementary School who inspired and shaped students' lives through Art Education – with the purpose of affording deserving students the opportunity to continue his/her education in Art Studio or Art Education after high school.

ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible, candidates shall be a graduating Fort Mill High School or Nation Ford High School senior which meet the following requirements:

- □ Have been accepted at an accredited two or four-year institution of higher learning or technical college;
- Be in good academic standing;
- □ Have an overall grade point average of 3.0 or higher; (This may be lowered by the Selection Committee if they see need and probability of success in the candidate.)
- □ In addition to the above-listed eligibility requirements, the following are considered: evidence of activity of a campus leader and promise of future achievement.

SELECTION PROCESS: A committee composed of an administrator, a guidance counselor, and vocational teachers shall review the applications and select the recipients.

AMOUNT: One \$1,000 scholarship.

APPLICATION: To apply please complete the application and prepare portfolio. Submit everything electonically to scholarships@ffms.org no later than March 1, 2018. Portfolio details below.

PORTFOLIO: Please include 10 images of your personal artwork. The first 5 artworks should reveal your range as an artist and include a variety of subject matter, media use and technique. The next 5 artworks should reveal a common theme or focus. Please include the title, medium, size and a brief description of each work along with a color image of the artwork. *Please submit portfolio items electronically as listed above.

DISBURSEMENT: The scholarship check will be made payable and sent directly to the university or college upon receipt of the Student Scholarship Acceptance Form (provided at award notification). Recipients will be announced at the Academic Awards in May.
