Describe your project, issue, need, program or activities.

Objectives

Page 2

Describe the specific measurable result expected within a particular time period, consistent with a goal and/or strategy.

Benefits

Top Page 3

Provide the number of students who will benefit and describe the potential for sharing with project other classrooms, grades and schools.

Outcomes & Impact

Bottom Page 3

Describe what impact this grant will have and/or what changes in knowledge, behavior or condition will occur as a result.

Timeline

Top Page 4

Be clearly stated with activities linked.

Budget & Other Financial Support

Bottom Page 4

Provide in a prioritized, line-item format which support the major objectives. If additional funding is required (for projects more than 10% requested amount), provide a supporting letter.

Letter of Support

Provide a Letter of Support from your Principal or Assistant Principal, including "I have read this proposal and approve its implementation within this school."
