

PHYLLIS H. FAIRCLOTH SPECIAL EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE: Phyllis H. Faircloth served 39 years as a special education teacher in the Fort Mill School District. Mrs. Faircloth was a dedicated teacher that extracted the best from each child she worked with. She was and still is a strong advocate for special education in the school and community. The Faircloth Special Education Scholarship was established in 2013 by Springfield Elementary School and her coworkers with the purpose of affording a deserving student from Fort Mill High or Nation Ford High the opportunity to pursue a degree in special education.

ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible, candidates shall be a graduating Fort Mill or Nation Ford High student which meets the following requirements:

Participated in the Early Childhood or Teacher Cadet program;
Have been accepted at an accredited four-year institution of higher learning;
Have a minimum 3.5 GPA (on weighted scale); and
Provide a 500 word essay on the topic listed below
Student involvement in extracurricular activities, community service, or charity
may be considered (especially activities that are special education related)

SELECTION PROCESS: A committee composed of a high school administrator, a guidance counselor, and the Early Childhood or Teacher Cadet teachers will review applications and essays and select a winner.

AMOUNT: One \$500 scholarship.

APPLICATION: Applicants are to submit a 500 word essay covering: "Why have you chosen to pursue a degree in special education? How do you intend to serve your community with this career? Describe any experiences you have had with a person with a disability and how were you positively impacted. Return your application and essay to Guidance **no later than March 1, 2019.**

DISBURSEMENT: The scholarship check will be made payable and sent directly to the university or college upon receipt of the Student Scholarship Acceptance Form (provided at award notification). Recipients will be announced at the Academic Awards in May.
