

The Malison Financial Group Scholarship 2022-23

PURPOSE: The Malison Financial Group Scholarship was established in 2015 to help provide financial support for deserving students from Fort Mill High School, Nation Ford High School, or Catawba Ridge High School to continue their education after high school. The scholarship is intended to support those students with an exceptional work ethic in any aspect of life and a demonstrated financial need.

ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible, candidates shall be a graduating Fort Mill High School, Nation Ford High School, or Catawba Ridge High School student. Key decision factors may include, but are not limited to the following:

- Exceptional work ethic in any aspect of life including, but not limited to, academics, extracurricular, community, employment, etc.
- Demonstrated financial need

Additionally, the candidate must fulfill the following requirements:

- Candidate must be accepted and committed to attending a two or four-year program at an accredited college, university, community college, technical college, apprenticeship or other technical institute in the United States.
- A letter of recommendation from an adult (non-relative) who can attest to your work ethic. (Ex. Teacher, Employer, Coach, Advisor, Counselor, etc.)
- Submit an essay (250 to 500 words) in response to one of the following topics:
 - 1. Tell us how you relate to a character or an event in a piece of literature that you have read.
 - 2. Describe where and how you show a strong work ethic in your life and how you believe that work ethic will benefit you in the future?

SELECTION PROCESS: A committee formed by the Malison Financial Group will review the applications and select the recipient.

AMOUNT: \$2,000.00 per year will be awarded <u>for up to four years</u>. Guidelines will be outlined and agreed upon by the recipient and the sponsor to maintain the scholarship consecutive years.

APPLICATION: To apply, complete application and essay and turn in to Guidance. The application and essay are due to Guidance **BY March 1, 2023.**

DISBURSEMENT: The scholarship check will be made payable and sent directly to the university or college upon receipt of the Student Scholarship Acceptance Form (provided at award notification). Recipient will be announced at the Academic Awards program in May.
