

F3 Fort Mill Community Scholarship 2021-22

PURPOSE: Established in 2022, the F3 Fort Mill Community Scholarship is a merit-based award that will be awarded to one graduating high school senior from each of the district high schools (Fort Mill, Nation Ford, and Catawba Ridge) who will be pursuing a two- or four- year college education. This \$1000 scholarship is for those who are balancing a role as student and citizen and is intended to support those students involved in their community and who possess excellent character.

ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible, a candidate shall be a graduating senior from Catawba Ridge School, Fort Mill High School or Nation Ford High School which meets the following requirements:

- Applicants must be enrolled or accepted into an accredited two-or four-year college
- Evidence of community involvement and/or extra-curricular activities
- Possess the following traits: dedicated student, outstanding character, high integrity, and passion for their chosen pursuit
- Exceptional work ethic in all aspects of life including, but not limited to academics, extracurricular, community, employment, etc.
- Personal statement outlining passion for the field of study they are entering (approx. 250 words is suggested length)

SELECTION PROCESS: A committee at each high school composed of a school administrator, a guidance counselor, and scholarship sponsor/ representative(s) will review applications and select a winner from each school.

AMOUNT: One-time award of \$1,000 to one graduating senior at each-- Catawba Ridge High, Fort Mill High School, and Nation Ford High School.

APPLICATION: To apply, complete application and personal statement, and turn in to Guidance BY March 1, 2022.

DISBURSEMENT: The scholarship check will be made payable and sent directly to the university or college upon receipt of the Student Scholarship Acceptance Form (provided at award notification). Recipient each year will be announced at the Academic Awards Program in May.

DEADLINE: Application is due to Guidance BY March 1, 2022
