

HUGH WHITE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE: The Hugh White Memorial Scholarship was established in 1994 to honor the memory of Hugh White -- an outstanding football player who excelled at life, showed love, defended the underdog, lead by example, and was a friend to all that knew him -- with the purpose of affording an outstanding football player from Fort Mill High School the opportunity to continue his education after high school.

ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible, candidates shall be a graduating Fort Mill High School student who meets the following requirements:

 Have been accepted at an accredited two or four-year institution of higher learning or technical college;
 Have played high school football; and
 Possess the following traits: outstanding character, outstanding leadership skills, outstanding student and athlete, exemplifies teamwork, and is self disciplined and has high integrity.

SELECTION PROCESS: A committee composed of a Fort Mill High School administrator, a guidance counselor, football coach and teachers shall nominate and select the recipient.

AMOUNT: One \$1,500 scholarship.

APPLICATION: Nominations are determined by coaching staff and teachers.

DISBURSEMENT: The scholarship check will be made payable and sent directly to the university or college upon receipt of the Student Scholarship Acceptance Form (provided at award notification). Recipient will be announced at the Fort Mill High School.
