

Lillian Dickert Gainey Memorial Scholarship 2021-22

PURPOSE: The Lillian Dickert Gainey Memorial Scholarship was established in 1996 to honor the memory of Lil Gainey a teacher, colleague, coach and sponsor for 21 years with the purpose of affording an outstanding foreign language student who has also participated in some form of extracurricular activity from Fort Mill High School the opportunity to continue his/her education after high school.

ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible, a candidate shall be a graduating Fort Mill High School student, which meets the following requirements:

- Have been accepted at an accredited two or four-- year institution of higher learning or technical college;
- Have an overall grade point average of 3.0 or higher;
- Successfully completed at least three years of foreign language studies; and
- Provide a 200 word statement about how your foreign language studies have affected you and how you have benefited.

SELECTION PROCESS: A committee composed of a Fort Mill High School administrator; guidance counselor, foreign language teachers, and one other teacher shall review the applications and select the recipient.

AMOUNT: One \$500 scholarship

APPLICATION: Applicants are to complete the application AND submit a 200 word essay covering: "How have your foreign language studies affected you and how have you benefitted from them?"

DISBURSEMENT: The scholarship check will be made payable and sent directly to the university or college upon receipt of the Student Scholarship Acceptance Form (provided at award notification). Recipient will be announced at the Academic Awards Program in May.

DEADLINE: Application and essay are due to Guidance BY March 1, 2022
