

Dalton Evans Memorial SCHOLARSHIP 2021-22 In Memory of Dalton Evans

PURPOSE: This scholarship memorializes the life of Dalton Evans, a Fort Mill High School graduate who was a friend to all, stranger to none; and above all was dedicated to his family. Dalton was a loving, caring southern soul with a devout passion for hunting, fishing, boating and sharing these experiences with good company. He touched and influenced the lives of so many in a positive way.

Proudly established in 2018 by his family, the \$1000 annual scholarship will be awarded to a Fort Mill High, Nation Ford High, or Catawba Ridge High student who shares Dalton's enthusiasm for the outdoors.

Applicants can use their creativity to illustrate their love of the outdoors through various forms of communication including but not limited to written, video, music, pictures or art.

ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible, a candidate shall be a graduating student from Fort Mill, Catawba Ridge, or Nation Ford which meets the following requirements:

- Have been accepted at an accredited two- or four-year institution of higher learning;
- Any major;
- Have a minimum 2.5 GPA (on either weighted or unweighted scale);
- Provide an unofficial transcript high school course work to date;
- SAT/Act score reported on application;
- Evidence of community service and/or extra-curricular activities;
- Provide a 500 word essay, photo montage, video or other media on the topic listed below;
- Have a demonstrated passion for hunting, fishing, and the outdoors

SELECTION PROCESS: A committee composed of a school administrator; a guidance counselor, scholarship sponsor/family member, and a teacher will review applications and essays/photos/videos/other media and select finalists from each school. A district committee will review candidates and select one recipient for the district.

AMOUNT: One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior at Fort Mill, Catawba Ridge, or Nation Ford.

APPLICATION: Applicants are to complete and submit the application attached. In addition, applicants are to submit a 500 word essay, photo montage, video, or other media showing their passion for hunting, fishing, and the outdoors. The application and supporting material are **DUE to Guidance no later than March 1, 2022.**

DISBURSEMENT: The scholarship check will be made payable and sent directly to the university or college upon receipt of the Student Scholarship Acceptance Form (provided at award notification). Recipient will be announced at the Academic Awards Ceremony in May.
