The Foundation for Fort Mill Schools held its 1st annual TEC Dowling Golf Tournament in May, raising \$18,000 to support the Foundation's grants, scholarships, and programs. The tournament is held in memory of TEC Dowling, who served as Superintendent of Fort Mill Schools from 1997 to 2005. He was a tireless advocate for "Children First" and was instrumental in the creation of the Foundation for Fort Mill Schools.

FFMS gets students Classroom Ready

For two days in August, Foundation for Fort Mill Schools staff and volunteers passed out school supplies and book bags for students in need as part of **Classroom Ready**, the foundation's school supply program.

On the first day of distribution, an elementary school boy excitedly approached the table to select a book bag. Without hesitation, he picked out a Spiderman book bag. "This is the best day ever," he said. "I am Spiderman's number one fan!"

His excitement was echoed over and over throughout the two days, as children and their parents picked up school supplies.

By the end of the event more than 350 book bags and 12,000 school supplies had been given to Fort Mill School District students in need. But that was just the beginning. In the following weeks, the Foundation reached out to guidance counselors to help continue identifying any remaining needs, so that all students could begin school with the supplies they need.

Guidance counselors were also invited to "shop" in **Ms. Moore's Room**, the Foundation's year-round free school supply room designed to continue serving children in need as additional supplies are required. A 3-year grant from the Springs Close Foundation provided school supplies to stock **Ms. Moore's Room** in memory of beloved Fort Mill educator Susan Moore. Generous contributions from district parents, community members, Shutterfly, and other business partners also helped make **Classroom Ready** a success.



Foundation grant brings fiction to life

Students in Nicole LaFave's English II class gathered in a courtyard at Fort Mill High School in October. Working in small groups, they talked excitedly about the book they had just finished reading, *Between Shades of Gray*. Together, they had created storyboards and planned costumes, all in preparation for filming a movie trailer about the book, using the iMovie application on iPad.

After completing their movie trailers, the class had a unique opportunity to Skype with author Ruta Sepetys. The iMovie application, books for the classroom, and the Skype session with the author were paid for by a Foundation for Fort Mill Schools grant.



"During the Skype session, students felt a connection with the author. Many told me after that they liked the book even more after chatting with her. She shared personal stories about her writing of the novel and even told us what happened to different characters in various drafts of the novel," LaFave said.

The grant also provided funds for Mrs. LaFave to purchase a yearlong subscription to Flipgrid, an application that allows her to pose questions to the students. They reply with self-recorded videos, which LaFave compiles for classroom discussion.

"Flipgrid is a great place for my shy students to discuss the book. After answering the question in privacy, I play the Flipgrid for the whole class to watch. It then elicits discussion. It's a wonderful tool for getting my quiet students to participate in class discussions," she said.

Mrs. LaFave received one of the Foundation for Fort Mill School's Innovative Classroom Project Grants. She was awarded \$600 to make her education vision a reality. Mrs. LaFave was one of 44 teachers awarded Innovative Classroom Project Grants, allowing them the financial resources to bring exciting ideas to their students.

"My project would not have been possible without the grant," LaFave said.
